

Teacher-led Research Programme



This programme will enable teachers and leaders at all levels to use practice-based research as a method of school improvement, development and self-evaluation. Participants will design and implement a research or innovation project which meets a priority in their school improvement plan.

This programme is suitable for teachers, middle leaders and senior leaders.



Format of the programme

- Customised session content based on participants' research interests and training needs survey results.
- Sessions framed around the three stages of the EEF's *DIY evaluation guide* - preparing for, implementing, analysing and reporting on a research or innovation project.
- A blended programme of group discussions, reading and discussing cutting-edge research & theory, practical workshops, sharing and commenting on project progress and in-school, teacher-led research activities.
- Between sessions participants will have access to a research mentor and optional twilight online discussions.
- Participants will develop and refine their own 'theory of change' to impact on pupil progress.
- A commitment to sharing findings through a research poster and showcase celebration in July 2019.
